DR. STONE RAISES \$2500 IN CHARITY GOLF OUTING



(Doylestown, PA) –Laurence Stone, D.D.S., M.A.G.D, with a Doylestown-based practice in Cosmetic and General Dentistry, hosted his second annual Charity “Open Wide” Open golf outing, proceeds of which will benefit Rotaplast International this year. The event raised \$2,500. The Open was held at Jericho National Golf Club, 250 Brownsburg Road East, New Hope, on Tuesday, September 12, 2006, with a shotgun start at 1:00 p.m.

Rotaplast International (www.rotaplast.org) was founded in 1992 as part of Rotary International to provide free reconstructive surgery and treatment for underprivileged children throughout the world suffering from untreated cleft lip and palate. The mission of Rotaplast became so strong that in 1996, Rotaplast became a separate non-profit organization, still heavily supported by Rotarians worldwide.

Dr. Stone, a member of the Warrington Rotary Club, became aware of the Rotaplast organization through the local Rotary district’s support, and had many local Rotarians as well as former district governor, Roger Whitcomb, participate in the event. “This year’s cause was particularly special to me as both a dentist and Rotarian,” states Dr. Stone. “I am grateful that so many signed up to participate and am pleased to be able to donate \$2,500 to Rotaplast.”
