As an Invisalign practice, Dr. Stone offers breakthrough technology to allow patients to have the smiles they always wanted without the hassle of braces.

Invisalign is a clear alternative to metal braces. The technology consists of a series of clear, removable aligners that straighten teeth over the course of treatment. Approximately every two weeks, patients will change their aligner and visit the dentist's office every 6 – 8 weeks to chart progress.

The Invisalign aligners are clear and comfortable to wear. They can be removed to eat, brush, and floss teeth. Because they are virtually invisible, patients also feel more comfortable smiling.

Invisalign can help improve smiles needing minor improvements or more extensive adjustments. It's successful in treating overly crowded or widely spaced teeth. It can also relieve more complex issues, including overbites, underbites and even crossbites.

Invisalign uses advanced 3-D computer imaging technology to transform patient's bite impressions into a custom-made series of clear and removable aligners. Each aligner moves teeth incrementally and is worn for about two weeks, then replaced by the next in the series until the final position is achieved.

The primary benefits of Invisalign include:

- Invisalign is clear, straightening teeth without anyone knowing.
- Invisalign is removable. Unlike braces, those using Invisalign can eat and drink what they want during treatment.
- Invisalign is comfortable. There are no metal brackets or wires as with braces to cause mouth irritation, and no metal or wires means greatly reducing time spent in the doctor's chair getting adjustments.
- Invisalign allows patients to view their own virtual treatment plan before they start to see you their straight teeth will look when treatment is complete.
