

Dr. Laurence Stone Attended National Conference

September, 2007 – Doylestown, PA - Laurence Stone, D.D.S., M.A.G.D., with a Doylestown-based practice in Cosmetic and General Dentistry, attended the American Dental Association's (ADA) 148th Annual Session at the Moscone Convention Center, San Francisco, CA, from September 27 – 30, 2007.

As Scientific Chair of the Second District Valley Forge Dental Association, serving dentists in Bucks and Montgomery counties, Dr. Stone used this opportunity to evaluate speakers for the Second District's future Valley Forge Dental Conferences.

During the ADA conference, an estimated 50,000 dental professionals experienced the latest in scientific and educational offerings and dental-industry exhibits. Leaders in dental practice, research, academics and industry presented more than 300 scientific sessions over four days, including lectures, hands-on workshops and special conferences.

The ADA'S Annual Session is the largest dental exhibition in the country, featuring more than 700 exhibitors.
