


Dr. Larry Stone Inducted As a Fellow in the American College of Dentists

Less than 3.5% of practicing dentists are invited to be fellows. Fellowship is by invitation only, based on recommendations from ACD Fellow dentists.

Most notably, the ACD has come to epitomize ethics and professionalism in dentistry. Currently the ACD is working on issues in corporate dentistry and commercialism.
