

DR. LAURENCE H. STONE NAMED A FELLOW IN THE INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF ORAL IMPLANTOLOGY

December 12, 2009 – Doylestown, PA - Laurence Stone, D.D.S., M.A.G.D., with a Doylestown-based practice in Cosmetic and General Dentistry, was named a Fellow in the International Congress of Oral Implantology (ICOI) at the 20th Annual New York University Dental School Implant Symposium held on December 12, 2009.

Founded in 1972, the ICOI is the world's largest dental implant organization and provider of continuing dental implant education to the entire dental team. To be credentialed as a Fellow in the ICOI, Dr. Stone was required to provide extensive documentation on implant cases in addition to completing over 200 hours in dental implant education over the preceding five years.

"Achieving a Fellowship in the ICOI is a significant milestone for me," states Dr. Stone. "It measures my progress in placing and restoring dental implants which is an unbelievable tool dentistry has developed to replace missing teeth and restore a person's ability to function and chew."

The ICOI, an affiliate of the FDI World Dental Federation, is comprised of general dentists, oral maxillofacial surgeons, periodontists, prosthodontists, endodontists, orthodontists, laboratory technicians, auxiliaries, industry representatives, researchers, faculty members, and pre and post doctoral graduate dental students.
